

MAD ArtsLife Summer 2013 Application

ArtsLife is a paid summer program for ten (10) high school students intended to help them gain practical work experience in a non-profit art museum setting. Participants will work part-time for seven weeks. Each participant will be expected to report to work Tuesday – Friday from 10:00a.m. to 4:00p.m. The 2013 program will begin on Tuesday, July 9th, 2013 and conclude on Friday, August 23th, 2013. Each participant will be paid a competitive wage. Applications must be received no later than 5:00 p.m., April 23rd, 2013.

Eligibility:

- Applicants must be a sophomore or junior in high school when applying.
- Applicants must live and attend high school in the 5 boroughs of New York City.
- Applicants must be able to commit to the entire 7-week program 4 days a week from July 9 - August 23, 2013.

All applicants must submit a fully completed application by 5:00 pm, April 23rd, 2013.

NOTE: Typewritten applications are preferred, but legibly handwritten applications will be accepted.

(1) Application Form: Make sure that all items are completed and signed, and that you include your address and phone number for the summer months.

(2) Personal Statement:

Please answer the following questions in a single, type-written page:

- Why you want to work at MAD and what you expect from the experience;
- What you hope to do in the future, your career objectives, and how you hope to achieve them;
- The qualities you possess that promote you as a candidate for this experience

(3) Recommendation Letters (2): One recommendation letter needs to come from a teacher, guidance counselor, or school administrator, The second letter can come from an adult who is neither a relative nor affiliated with the high school of the applicant (i.e. employer, member of clergy, coach, etc.).

Deadlines: All application materials must be postmarked by April 23rd, 2013.
