- (3) Recommendation Letters (2): One recommendation letter needs to come from a teacher, guidance counselor, or school administrator, The second letter can come from an adult who is neither a relative nor affiliated with the high school of the applicant (i.e. employer, member of clergy, coach, etc.).

NOTE: Typewritten applications are preferred, but legibly handwritten applications will be accepted.
