- Cardboard boxes, flats & rolls
- Recycled materials: cereal boxes, plastic containers, jars, paper plates etc.
- Cardstock (any color is fine)
- Construction paper
- Sketchbook
- Scissors

- Glue stick or liquid glue (multi-purpose or craft glue)
- Aluminum foil
- String
- Pipe cleaners
- Popsicle sticks
- Drawing materials (such as markers, colored pencils, oil pastels etc.)
- Optional: Paintbrushes and paints (any kind) for adding color

DAY 1 WEAVING

- 1. Cardboard: approx. 12"x 6" with no folds, should be strong and even
- 2. Ruler
- 3. Marker
- 4. Strong Scissors
- 5. Yarn, twine, or heavy string (at least 6 yards)
- 6. Clean rags, clothes you don't mind destroying, or fabrics.
- 7. Ribbons, long straight sticks, natural items like plants with long stems (OPTIONAL)

DAY 2 HOMEMADE PAPER

- 1. 6" x 12" <u>Metal hardware cloth</u> (cut down to this size)
- 2. Recycled paper: old mail, unglossy magazines, newspaper, construction, or printer paper
- 3. Water source
- 4. Blender (please use with adult supervision if necessary)
- 5. Paper towels
- 6. Multiple flat cardboard pieces
- 7. A variety of large, 2lb Tupperware or plastic containers (at least 3)
- 8. Big spoon
- 9. Strong scissors

DAY 3 CLOTH CYANOTYPES

- 1. Scissors
- 2. Tape
- 3. Sharpie
- <u>Cyanotype Cloth</u> (1) UNOPENED as it is photosensitive These are also options: <u>cyanotype cloth</u> (2), <u>cyanotype cloth</u> (3) Since this is a more expensive item, you may prefer to get cyanotype paper.
- 5. <u>acetate sheets</u>: check your packet of cyanotype paper first to see if it already contains acetate sheets.
- 6. Pencil and paper
- 7. Magazines or source images with inspiration

DAY 4 WEARABLE ART

- 1. Found objects. Could be any TWO of the following:
 - One or two articles of unwanted clothing that can be completely transformed
 - Roll of wide duct tape (any color or grey)
 - Clean recycled bottles
- 2. Strong scissors
- 3. Elmer's glue

DAY 5 EMBROIDERY

- 1. Two pieces of solid colored, even-textured fabric scrap cut to 12" x 12"
- 2. Needle with big eye
- 3. Embroidery thread: 3 colors, 3 yards of each
- 4. Scissors
- 5. Needle threader (optional)
- 6. One Embroidery Hoop
- 7. Plain T Shirt you can transform. (Any color, something you want to work with and wear again)
